

Retford Runners take on the Askern 10 mile

Retford Athletics had nine members of their senior running club compete in the Askern 10 mile road race. The course began with a good straight before climbing some of the hills around the outskirts of Doncaster and then heading back towards Askern to complete the course. The first home for Retford in a time of 59m05s came Pete Tallents. This placed him 13th out of 344 runners. The next home for Retford came Andy Kinsley completing the 10 miles in a time of 71m27s and finishing in the top 100. Stephen Firman and father in law John Sinclair crossed the line next in times of 72m25s and 78m55s respectively. David Corbett shook of a bad stomach to finish in a time of 80m20s, closely followed by Ollie Lord who competed in Nottingham's Outlaw Iron Man just a few weeks ago and finished the 10 miles in 84m00s. Terry Lovett continued to build on a good season finishing in 91m08s. Christopher Colclough and Kenneth Neal rounded of the Retford runners in times of 98m33s and 108m56s respectively.
